Material for Disc Pressing:

You can provide the material for pressing in the form of:

- Source Disc
- O Disc Image

Source Discs:

- Use high-quality recordable discs for source discs(CD-R, DVD+/-R/R DL) or pressed DVDs/CDs.
- Ensure the disc surface is free from defects, scratches, or fingerprints before burning.

Burn the disc at the appropriate speed for its format:

- CD and CD-R 700MB x24
- DVD5 and DVD-R 4.7GB x16

Acceptable Formats:

- ⟨ CD-ROM Mode 1 (Yellow Book)
- (7) CD-ROM XA Mode 2 (VCD, SVCD) (Yellow Book)

Acceptable File Systems:

- √ ISO/UDF
- √ UDF

CD Audio	max 78 min
CD-ROM	max 682 MB
Mini-CD Audio	max 23 min
Mini-CD ROM	max 210 MB
DVD-5	max 4,7 GB
DVD-9	max 8,54 GB
DVD-10	max 2x4,7 GB

Disc Image Transfer:

- ✓ Preferred method: FTP (login details provided after order) or Wetransfer link
- Alternatively, use portable HDDs or Flash drives.
- Acceptable formats: **DDP ver. 2.00ISO**, NRG, CUE/BIN, CUE/WAV, IMG, MDS/ISO,

Essentials:

- ✓ Include an MD5 checksum file with disc images to verify correctness. Download a free MD5 tool: http://md5summer.org/md5v12005.zip
- Ensure the material is in the correct format and plays correctly. We suggest testing the source disc on multiple devices (for CD-ROMs and DVD-ROMs) and on CD (for CD-Audio) or DVD players (for DVD-Video).
- For increased security, we recommend sending two source discs.
- ✓ Label source discs with markers intended for this purpose. NEVER use a pen!
- Compress your files in ZIP or RAR.
